- No personal check accepted.

- Cancellations are accepted up until 4:00 P.M. the day of arrival.

We will make all the necessary arrangements for you. If you are planning to attend, and desire to have a room reserved for you, please remit \$54.13 for the room and \$23.00 per person for the dinner.
